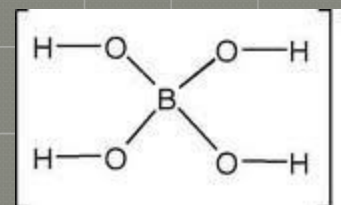
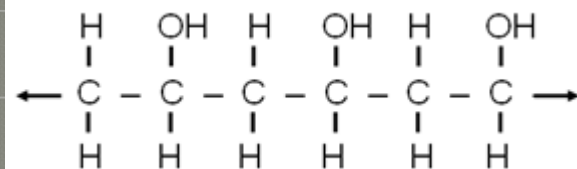

- Glitter

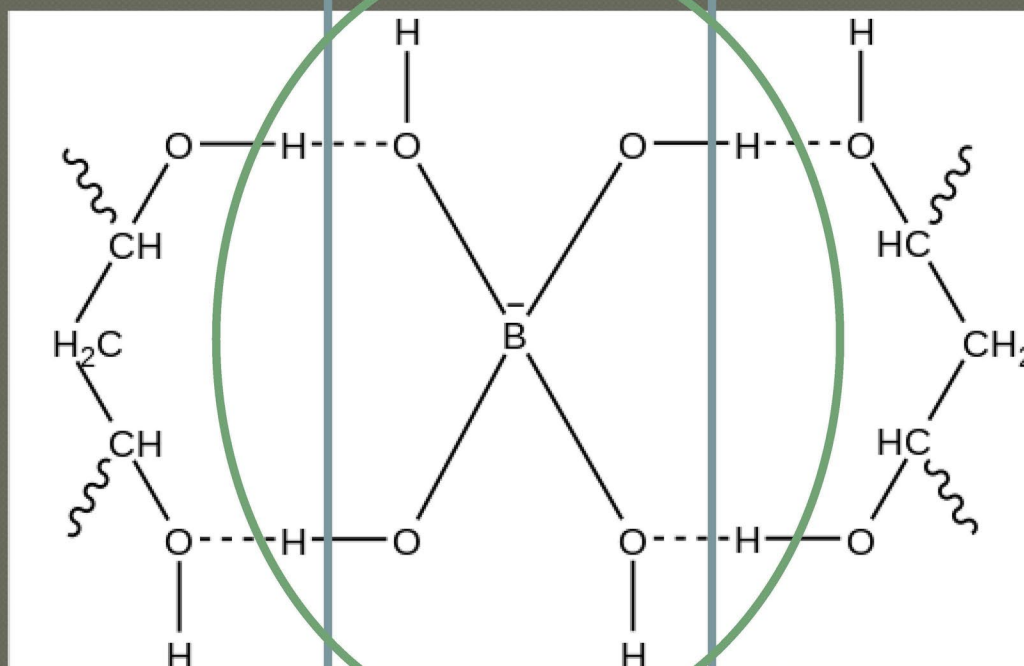
